## "So what are the specs, and how do I choose?"

**12" Closed-Handle Dovetail Saw, \$210** (for options pricing, see product pages for my other saws):

- Cherry or optional walnut handle patterned after Wheeler Madden Clemson, circa 1867
- .02-thin plate, filed 14 ppi rip, premium Swedish Spring Steel
- Hot-Blued or optional stainless back
- 2 1/2" under the back at the heel, 2 3/8" at the toe
- Brass slotted fasteners, or your choice of optional, gunsmith-blued or stainless steel fasteners, split-nuts or slotted design
- **Utility:** this is a hybrid dovetail/small tenon saw, a great choice when creating 3/4+ sized dovetails and for ripping 2" deep tenon cheeks. The closed handle offers fabulous control, which, along with the longer plate saws straight and true where accuracy counts the most.

**12" Open-Handle Dovetail Saw, \$195** (for options pricing, see product pages for my other saws) :

- Cherry or optional walnut handle patterned after Disston's open handle design, circa 1887.
- .02-thin plate, filed 14 ppi rip, premium Swedish Spring Steel
- Hot-Blued or optional stainless back
- 2 1/2" under the back at the heel, 2 3/8" at the toe
- Brass slotted fasteners, or your choice of optional, gunsmith-blued or stainless steel fasteners, split-nuts or slotted design
- **Utility:** this is a hybrid dovetail/small tenon saw, a great choice when creating 3/4+ sized dovetails and for ripping 2" deep tenon cheeks. - .018-thin plate, filed 16 ppi rip, premium Swedish Spring Steel
- Hot-Blued or optional stainless back
- 2" under the back at the heel, 1 7/8" at the toe
- Brass slotted fasteners, or your choice of optional, gunsmith-blued or stainless steel fasteners, split-nuts or slotted design
- **Utility:** this is a classic dovetail open-handled saw, a great choice for finer work between 1/4 and 3/4 thick.

So there's the Bad Axe Dovetail Saw update. "Mark . . . the (14" sash) saws are awesome. I tried out the crosscut saw first on a 2" thick chunk of white oak. Went right thru it, and what amazed me the most was the end grain on the piece after the cut. It was literally smooth as glass. Could not tell it apart from a cut using my forrest blade on the tablesaw, except for the fact that mine was crooked. I obviously need more practice. Tried the rip on some maple I had laying around, tracked right to the line and cut FAST . . . these saws have already made me a better hand tool woodworker and I'm pretty sure I'll be using them constantly. They are also the best looking tools I own."
